The Organization of Staff Analysts awards our new leader, Randi Weingarten, the well deserved title of labor hero.

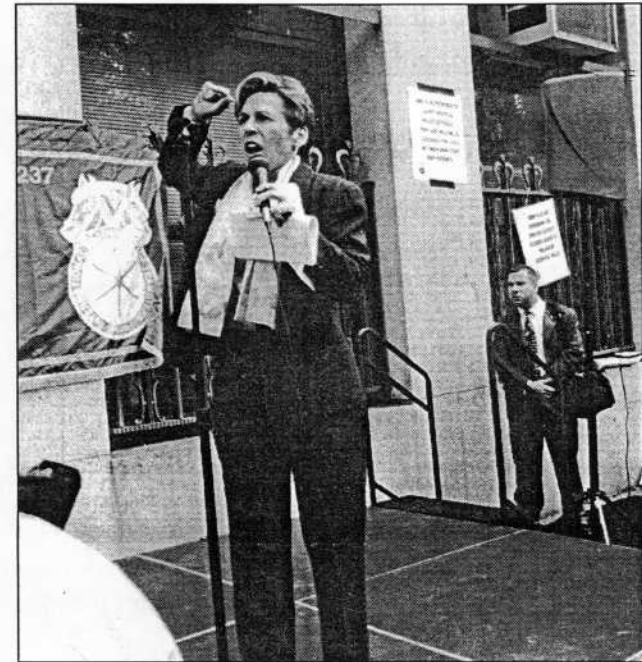
