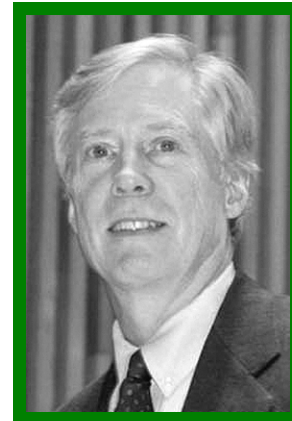
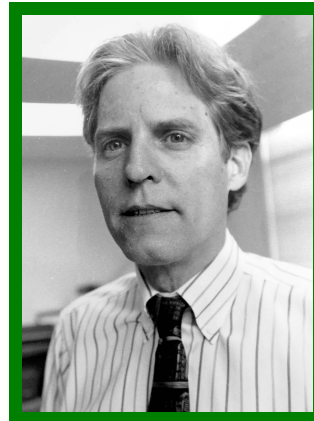
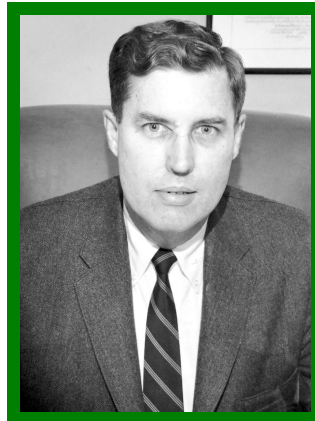


# OSA's LABOR HEROES OF 2021

## THE PRIAL FAMILY – PUBLISHING THE STORIES OF NEW YORK CITY'S CIVIL SERVANTS FOR MORE THAN A CENTURY



For over one hundred years, a single New York family provided our City with one of its finest institutions, the Civil Service newspaper *The Chief*.

Need a job with the City, State or Federal government?

*The Chief* was the place to start looking. Waves of first and second generation immigrants started their climb towards financial stability and even middle class status by learning

of jobs through the newspaper.

You did not need connections, you could just take an exam. Later, your children and grandchildren might follow in your footsteps, and they too would read *The Chief*.

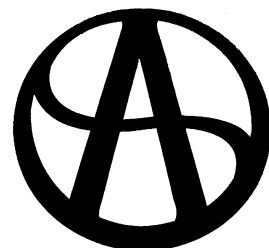
*The Chief* is the hometown newspaper for hundreds of thousands of government workers and the unions that represent them. It chronicles our lives and times as no other newspaper does. It is our own "Paper of

Record" and we owe it all to a single family for the past one hundred years.

Beginning in 1919, when Frank J. Prial and his associates purchased an independent newspaper for fire-fighters originally founded in 1897, there was a Frank Prial in charge for three full generations and an Ed, Jim Michael and Joe Prial keeping the paper and faith in Civil Service alive even longer.

In return for a century of the Prial family's commitment and excellence in recording and reporting the stories of the civil servants of the City of New York, the Organization of Staff Analysts dedicates our Labor Hero of 2021 Award to this remarkable family that did so much, for so long, for so many of us.
