



Updated Information about NYC Subway Service Changes

Dear NYCHA Employees,

Beginning late tonight (Wednesday, May 6 at 1 a.m.), MTA-New York City Transit will discontinue late-night subway service from 1 a.m. to 5 a.m. until further notice. During this time, the MTA will provide expanded bus service, cross honor MetroCards for commuter rails, and provide one free for-hire vehicle trip each night for essential workers.

NYCHA employees who need to access the for-hire vehicle service must register through the [MTA's Essential Connector service](#). Once registered online, you can call 511 to schedule a trip.

Please note that the MTA is limiting this service to those who would otherwise travel more than one hour and twenty minutes by bus or would require more than two bus transfers to get to work.
